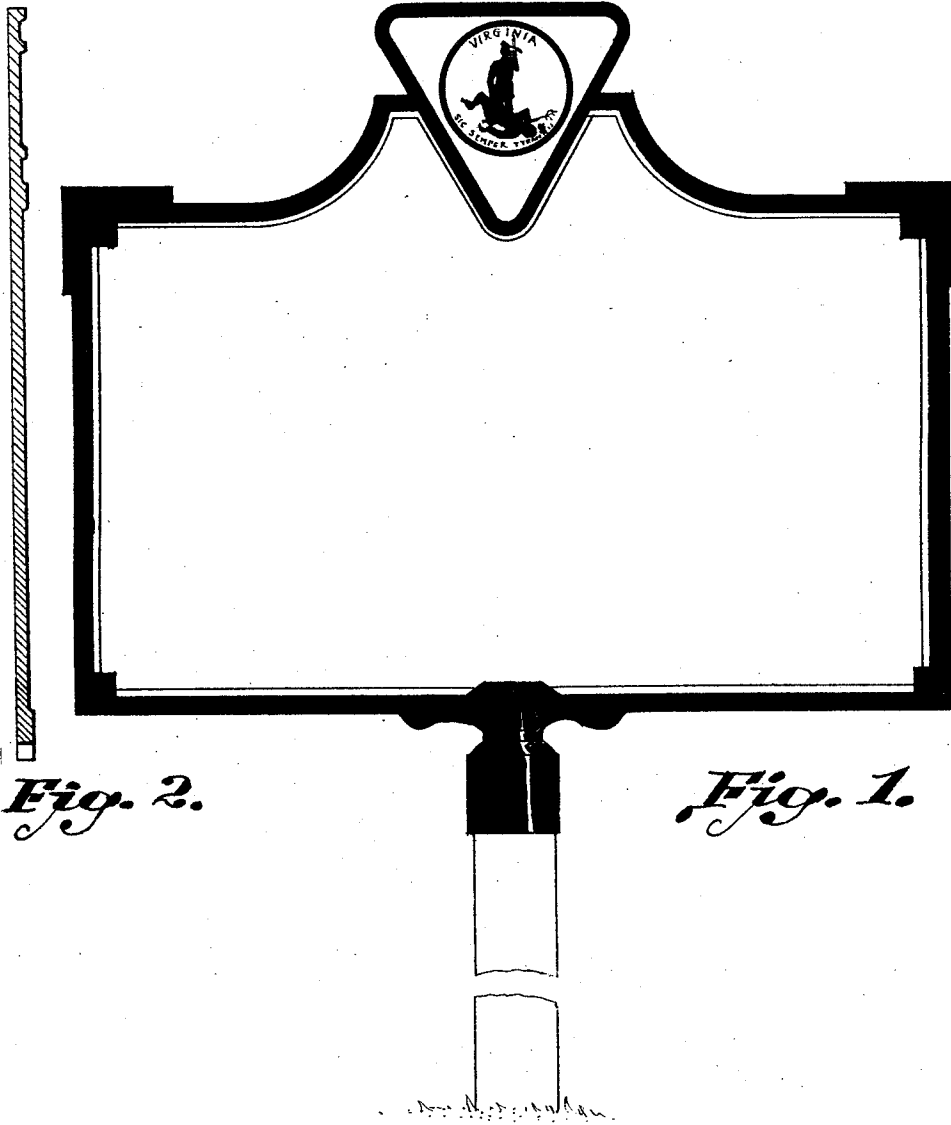

DESIGN FOR A ROAD SIGN.

To all whom it may concern:
